TO SHIP A CAR BETWEEN THE U.S.V.I. ON THE NORMA H:

- If your car is currently registered in STT or STX, bring us either the original registration or a legible photocopy. You do not need any other paperwork.
- If your car is NOT currently registered, see page 2 of this document for additional instructions.
- Bring the keys and your vehicle, along with the registration or a photocopy, to the Norma H booth during regular working hours.

Please call a few days ahead of time to ensure there is room for your vehicle!!

Shipping rates for standard vehicles range from \$280 - \$350 depending on weight.

These prices include all Port Authority fees.

These prices do not include any fuel surcharges that may currently be in effect.

Larger vehicles or those not in working condition may incur a higher price.

IF YOUR CAR IS NOT CURRENTLY REGISTERED IN THE USVI:

- Obtain a letter from your bank advising of any liens on the car.
If the car was paid for in cash, obtain a copy of the receipt.
- Take the letter / receipt to the Lieutenant Governor's office.
(If you don't have the letter, they will get it themselves, extending the process.)
- The LG's Office will give you a letter to take to the Inspection Lane. At the Inspection Lane you will get a VIN check and be given another paper called a "Vehicle Clearance Form." The Clearance Form is valid for 60 days and can be used multiple times during this period.
When they fill out and stamp it, make certain they fill in the VIN # correctly.
This is done at a separate window.
- Bring the keys and all your paperwork (including your registration or a photocopy of it) to the Norma H booth.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

I just purchased my car from someone else, and it is still registered in their name. Do I have to go to the Lt. Governor's office?

No, not as long as the registration is current. Bring a copy of your bill of sale (or signed title) showing the name of the previous owner. If that matches what is on the registration, you do not have to do anything else.

My car is wrecked and doesn't run. It hasn't been registered in years. Do I have to go to the Lt. Governor's office?

No. If it is not drivable and comes to us on a tow truck, we can usually move the vehicle without any additional paperwork other than proof of ownership. If you have an older (expired) registration, bring that.

Can someone else drop off (or pick up) the car for me?

Yes, absolutely.

Can I pack my stuff in the car?

Yes. Any household goods, tools, etc. that fit in the car (or safely on top of it) can go with it for no additional charge. Please note, the Norma H crew must be able to SAFELY DRIVE THE VEHICLE at all times.

Can I ride the boat along with my car?

No, sorry. We don't take passengers.
